13. AWARDS:
 1. Team Trophies: 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place
 2. Individual Medals: 1st place, 2nd place, 3rd place, 4th place
 3. Qualifiers to State: Top 3 places
 4. Pictures: State qualifiers pictures will be taken immediately after the awards. Must be in team uniform, no bandanas, hats, etc for picture.

14. DISPUTES:
 1. All disputes will be presented to the Tournament Manager who will forward them to the Games Committee for review and resolution.
 2. WIAA ejection rule will be in effect. Wrestlers will be barred from further competition (remainder of the Regional and All of the State Tournament) if:
 1. Ejected for First Instance of Flagrant Misconduct (Federation Rule) or,
 2. Ejected for Second Instance of Unsportsmanlike Conduct (Federation Rule) of an “abusive” nature (WIAA Standard)
 3. Ejection of a coach results in removal from the Regionals Tournament and the first scheduled match the following year.

15. FACILITIES: Our facilities are limited and seating space will be tight. We ask that all spectators limit themselves to their seats only.
 1. Locker Rooms: We will have 2 locker rooms w/ showers available and one locker room w/o shower facilities. Please plan to be responsible for securing your valuables. Also plan to keep the locker rooms clean and garbage cans will be available in the locker room.
 2. Towels, bring your own.
 3. Floor restrictions: No one will be permitted to stand along the mats, including coaches, wrestlers and spectators. This area will be clearly marked and no one is inside this area.
 4. We will provide rooms for the wrestlers to go to relax and get away from the floor area.

16. BREAKFASTS:
 1. Breakfast will be on sale from 8:00-9:30A in the Student Center.

17. PARKING:

1. School Buses: Buses will park at the far south end of campus and we will have people there to direct the buses where to go. Cars will be parked on a first come, first served basis.

18. SCHOOL BANNERS ONLY: No other types of signs will be allowed. Coaches please help in supervising the rule.

19. NO SCHOOL BANDS OR ANY TYPE OF NOISE MAKER WILL BE ALLOWED.

20. TEAM SCORING:

1. All tournament scoring will follow National Federation Rule Book Guidelines (Rule 9, Section 2)
2. Team Placement:
 1. 1st Place: 16 pts
 2. 2nd Place: 12 pts.
 3. 3rd Place: 9 pts.
 4. 4th Place: 7 pts.
 5. 5th Place: 5 pts.
 6. 6th Place: 3 pts

21. TOURNAMENT SCORING:

1. Individual placement points shall be awarded as soon as earned. Placement points already earned will be deducted in case of forfeit (other than injury) or disqualification from the tournament.
2. Points for team scoring shall be awarded as follows:
 1. (2) team advancement points shall be scored for each match won in the championship bracket, except for the final first place match. If a wrestler receives a bye in the first round, he shall be awarded 2 advancement points for that round if he wins his next match. No points are awarded for the bye if he loses the next match.
 2. (1) team advancement point shall be scored for each match won in the consolation round, except for the final 3rd and 5th place matches. A wrestler who has a bye in the consolations round shall receive one advancement point, provided he wins the next round match.
 3. Points for Default, Disqualification, Fall, or Forfeit:
 1. 2 additional points will be scored for each match won by default.
 2. 1 ½ points will be awarded for each match won by a technical fall.
 3. 1 point will be awarded for each match won by a major decision.

22. WITHDRAWAL OF QUALIFIERS:

1. Any school that intends to withdraw a qualified participant should contact the tournament manager as soon as possible. This will allow time to contact the alternates.

23. COACHES HOSPITALITY ROOM: We will have a coaches hospitality room for the coaches and volunteers stocked with plenty of food. It will open at 10:00A and run through till about 6:00P. You will receive a wrist band in your coaches packet and entry into the hospitality room will be with that wrist band.

24. COACHES PACKETS: The packets will be given to the coaches when they arrive. There will be a desk in the lobby and we will issue them when you arrive. Weigh In cards will be in the packets as well.

25. DIRECTIONS TO TACOMA :

1. FROM THE SOUTH: going south on I-5, take exit 130 west bound. turn left onto Tacoma Mall Boulevard heading south. Cross over 56th Street and continue south, turn right on 64th Street and go down the hill. Go past the school and turn left at the round about. Go to 66th and turn left. When you enter the parking lot, turn right and go along the buildings till you pass the the last building and park behind the last building. We will have parking lot attendants there to direct you.
2. FROM THE NORTH: going north on I-5, take exit 129 and cross back over the freeway. Turn right onto Tacoma Mall Boulevard and head north on Tacoma Mall Boulevard. Turn left on 64th Street and go down the hill. Go past the school and turn left at the round about. Go to 66th and turn left. When you enter the parking lot, turn right and go along the buildings till you pass the last building and park behind the last building. We will have parking lot attendants there to direct you.

26. CROWD CONTROL:

1. Crowd control at Regionals is a responsibility that must be shared by the administration and coaches of all participating schools. All of us must work closely with Tournament Management to control the conduct of our students and adult fans. Coaches: please inform your fans, athletes, etc. that they are not allowed down on the floor.

27. MEDIA:

1. Only media and photographers with credentials will be allowed down on the floor.
2. No video cameras of any kind (including cell phones) will not be allowed on the floor. Any filming must take place from the stands.
3. All photographers must take pictures from behind the ropes, but not in front of the bleachers.
